Guide to Navigating the Online Interactive Map of Alternatives**

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NAVIGATION:

- **To zoom**, use the Zoom in button + or the Zoom out button – in the top left corner of the map or, if applicable, the scroll wheel on your mouse.
- To zoom the map back to its initial extent, click the  button located below to the zoom buttons.
- **To pan left, right, up, or down**, click and drag the map or use the arrow keys on your keyboard.

LEGEND:



The **Legend** Button displays a legend for the 10 build alternatives, the associated right-of-ways, the terminus points, and property parcel lines.

- Each alignment has a designated color and each right-of-way appears as a black dashed line.
- Each property parcel that is crossed by an alignment is shown on the map. To view ownership, click within the parcel boundary lines.

LAYERS:



The **Layers** Button displays an operational layer for each build alternative. You can turn layers on and off by checking the box to the left of the layer.

To view one alternative at a time, make sure all other alternatives are unchecked.


BASEMAP GALLERY:



The **Basemap Gallery** Button opens a gallery from which you can select a new map to appear behind the alternatives.

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PRINT:




The **Print** Button allows you to print the current view of the map.

1.  **ArcGIS Web Map**

To print:

- Zoom and Navigate to the area of the map you wish to print
- Name the map
- Select desired layout
- Select desired format

To **expand** or **collapse** the menu on the left side of the screen, click this double arrow symbol at the bottom left corner of the page.
